Can you give an example of an intervention, specifically scope and outcome, that HRSA is interested in funding?

It is up to each applicant to propose intervention studies based on their expert knowledge of the existing gaps in the MCH Measurement field. While there are many ways to define the term “intervention”, we define it to include behavioral, social, or structural/health systems approaches, as well as a combination of applied clinic-medical and behavioral, social, or structural/health system approaches that contribute to the prevention of diseases or improvement of health (including clinical) outcomes for mothers, children and families at a population level. We have also outlined in the NOFO the MCH frameworks and HHS/HRSA priority topical areas (pp. 1, 10, 21) to guide you.
