38.7% do not have any medical insurance.

- o 53.6% female, 46.4 % male.
- under 18 years of age: 36.7% congenital causes, 21% sickness, 11.6% unknown.
- 39.5% motor disabilities: 61.6% MMII, 30 % MMSS and MMII and 8.4% MMSS.
- 59.13% motor disability and other related.
- 24.7% diagnosed at birth or before their 4 years old of age.
